CAPITAL ARTS

Performing arts company, Capital Arts, was founded in 1989 by its Artistic Director, Kathleen Shanks.

Opera Capital Arts

Founded in 2015 OPERA CAPITAL ARTS is a freelance professional opera company. Soloists are booked from the major London opera companies with London Cantamusica as the chorus. The Capital Arts Children's Choir and London Youth Music Theatre sing the children's chorus when required.

London Cantamusica

Founded in November 2014, London Cantamusica is a choir of professional singers. The choir has an ad hoc schedule of rehearsals, linked to performances and productions. Rehearsals are held on Saturday afternoons in Covent Garden. The choir gives its own recitals in London and has a busy programme of recordings at the Abbey Road Studios

Capital Arts Children's Choir

The Capital Arts Children's Choir is a world class children's choir with an international reputation. The choir's extensive biography of recitals, concerts, operas, musicals, radio and TV performances, films and international concert tours, makes it one of the busiest and most successful children's choirs in the UK with an unequalled biography of professional performances. The choir's ease with all genres of music makes Capital Arts a natural choice for musicians and promoters.

Angelic Voices

Angelic Voices is a highly trained, talented group of soloists from the Capital Arts Children's Choir. Angelic Voices has performed on radio and television and given numerous recitals in this country and abroad. Angelic Voices made its TV debut as top billing soloists at a 'Voice In A Million' concert at the O2 Arena, London. Angelic Voices sings as 'Angelis' for Sony BMG.

London Youth Music Theatre Company

London Youth Music Theatre is a national performing arts company for youngsters to train with and perform with professional musicians, actors, singers, dancers, directors and choreographers who work in West End musicals and London opera companies.

Opera Minor Education Outreach Scheme

Founded in 2002 the Capital Arts Children's Choir, supported by sponsorship and grants, has run an education outreach scheme, Opera Minor, which, in tandem with local schools, gives rehearsal and performance opportunities to Hertfordshire children.

Kathleen Shanks
Artistic Director & Music Director

Kathleen divides her professional career between her work as a music director, composer and artistic director of Capital Arts. She has also worked as a music consultant for major record labels Decca and Sony BMG and she arranged music for the film 'Assassin's Creed' for Twentieth Century Fox, starring Jeremy Irons and Michael Fassbender. As a Music Director, Kathleen has specialised in opera and musicals. She has trained children's choruses for West End Shows for a number of production companies including Andrew Lloyd Webber's the Really Useful Group, Cameron Mackintosh Ltd and Bill Kenwright Ltd. She has trained children's choruses for the main opera houses in London as well as major classical choral works for London choirs and orchestras. Kathleen has conducted at all the major London concert halls for Raymond Gubbay's 'Glory of Christmas' concerts. She has performed before royalty on a number of occasions and for state leaders at Chequers and 10, Downing Street. Kathleen's New York performances are sponsored by Bond No9 perfume. Her music is published by the American publishing company, Hal Leonard Corporation.



John Cuthbert Accompanist, Répétiteur & Singer

John is an talented piano accompanist, répétiteur and orchestral pianist. He divides his professional career between his accompanying work and singing. John has a catalogue of recordings from his accompanying work at the Abbey Road Studios. He has worked with the International Gilbert & Sullivan Festival Touring Company and Co-Opera Company. With members of both these companies, John has performed live on BBC Radio 3's In Tune. As an orchestral pianist, John has performed with CLS, LSO and LPO at the Royal Albert Hall, and in Salzburg and Lucerne.



Júlia Gyulai Choreographer

Júlia trained at the Hungarian Dance Academy. She has performed as a contemporary dancer at the Hungarian State Opera and solo dancer for the Andrea Bocelli concert in Budapest. Her acting credits include Chicago, Hair, Gone With The Wind and Evita, plus the recent off-West End production of the Wrong Shoe Company. Júlia has recently taken the lead role in Blackburn Empire Theatre's pantomime Dick Whittington. She filmed for the BBC mini-series, The North Water. INVICTUS

In 2012 I was commissioned to write the official children's anthem, 'Gloria In Londinium' for the London Olympics. The song was recorded at the Abbey Road Studios by over 300 Opera Minor children from Welwyn Hatfield, Hertfordshire. A film of the song was broadcast world-wide throughout the Olympic Games. With its rousing chorus, Invictus Invictus, 'Gloria In Londinium' was broadcast during Prince Harry's first Invictus Games in 2014. For the Invictus Games 2022 I have been commissioned to write a song detailing the humanitarian aspect of life as a soldier. I chose the humanitarian work of the soldiers at Kabul airport.

The Opera Minor Invictus children's choir was formed to be part of the new 2022 Netherlands Invictus Games fanfare, adapted from the original Invictus anthem. Hertfordshire schools represented are: Brookmans Park, Cranborne, Ladbrooke, Little Heath, Oakmere, St. Columba's College and The Ryde.
